Recommended Illustrations

IRIAM is an application that allows anyone to easily stream any character if you have a mobile device and an illustration! This guidebook provides basic information on how to draw illustrations suitable for streaming with IRIAM. Start streaming with your character by preparing illustrations that resonate with you!



· If thick lines and evident brush strokes cause the image to not load properly, try reducing the unevenness of your lines or using a more cartoonlike style. We recommend drawing clearly, distinctly, and plainly.

· Moving parts can be calibrated. If you feel the image is moving too much, go to the Stream Preparation screen and calibrate the part you want.

Key Points for Creating Illustrations

The hair should not overlap with the body —---



The overlapping area will be blurred or cut off if the hair hangs in front of the body. It is recommended that the hair be drawn to not overlap with the body.

TIPS

- · Drawing clean lines and shapely hair may improve display quality.
- · Head accessories are less likely to be cut off if they do not stick to the body.
- · Separating the hair color from the color of the clothes reduces the risk of poor recognition.




Compact Head Parts —--



Since parts extending upward will cut off, putting them closer to the head is best. The closer the parts are to the head, the smoother the movement quality will be.


 \cdot We recommend loading the image and checking its movement before finalizing your illustration.

Leave space between eyes and bangs for better results -----



Hair that falls over the eyes may appear blurry. Be sure to separate them.

Draw hair and eyebrows separately to make them easier to recognize —--




The app can more easily recognize the eyebrows if the length of bangs does not end where the eyebrows are, and if they are a different color than the hair. Also, if the thickness of the eyebrows is an issue, adjust the original illustration.

TIPS

- · Looking worried or surprised is easier if you make the eyebrows simple and not angled.
- Eyebrows that are too short may be difficult to recognize, in which case making them longer may fix the issue.

Eyes should be drawn in clear, simple shapes ----




It makes the eyes more challenging to recognize if there is too much makeup or if the eyelashes are overdrawn. We recommend that the outline of the eyes be drawn as simply and clearly as possible.

TIPS

- \cdot Creating the sclera separately from the eyes and eyeliner will make eye movements more fluid.
- · Lower eyelashes will be easier to recognize if the connection between the eyeliner and lower eyelashes is clear.

Leaving out the outline of the mouth may reduce recognition ——•



The mouth is easier to recognize when it is outlined clearly. In addition, it is easier to make facial expressions more fluid if the mouth is opened at about 2/3 of its maximum capacity!

TIPS

- The shape and movement of the mouth can be calibrated.
- · A rounded mouth allows for a richer variation of facial expressions.




Keep teeth as simple as possible, or consider not including them at all ----



Drawing full-grown teeth may cause poor recognition. If that happens, either remove the teeth or draw them simpler and smaller.

Markings on the face are less likely to disappear when the face is flushed —--



Things like moles and face paint are less likely to fade if kept away from the eyes and with some blush added to the cheeks.


Examples of illustrations that cannot be loaded properly or are not recommended:


*In preparation for things such as events, having high-resolution data and the data used for streaming will allow for a cleaner display when producing large prints such as life-size posters or larger sizes.

Illustration FAQs and Solutions

Q. The hair gets cut off.

Illustration Notes

To protect all streamers and viewers, IRIAM prohibits the following illustrations for streaming. For more details, please refer to the User Guidelines.

Prohibited Illustrations

- Illustrations that go against public moral standards.
- Illustrations that may offend third parties.
- Illustrations that infringe on the rights of third parties.
- Illustrations that include personal information such as real names.
- Illustrations that include real-life photos of people or animals.
- Other illustrations deemed inappropriate by the IRIAM team.

When a stream is monetized, we get confirmation from the streamers themselves to confirm that they are not using any prohibited illustrations.

If you are using prohibited illustrations and falsely report otherwise, we may cancel your monetization or suspend your account, in accordance with our Terms of Service.

Please note that if your account is suspended, you may lose any Points purchased or Points given to you by viewers. *The nature of rights can be difficult to determine. Please be careful that third parties do not unilaterally decide you have infringed on their rights.
